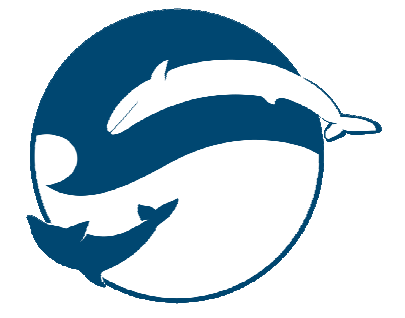

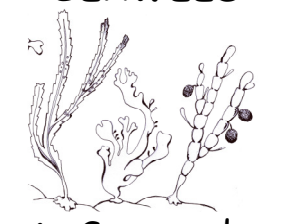
I have seen a

Can breathe underwater by filtering the oxygen out of the water.

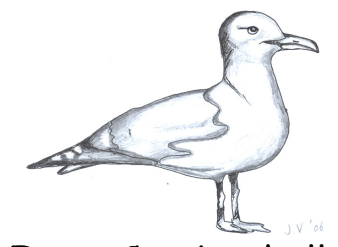
I have seen a

 I have seen three colours of Seaweed



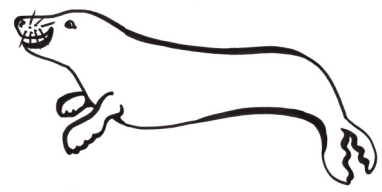
HERRING GULL
 I have seen a Herring Gull
Cracks shells to get the food inside by dropping them from high up onto rocks. Red legs and spot on beak.



PURPLE TOPSHELL
 I have seen a Purple Topshell
A type of sea snail. Grazes on algae as it crawls over seaweed. Purple stripes over the shell.



SEAL
 I have seen a Seal
Seals have blubber (fat) to keep them warm and it also cushions them when they lie on rocks.



OYSTERCATCHER
 I have seen an Oystercatcher
Likes to eat cockles, mussels and worms. Gets into shells by stabbing or hammering using its strong red beak.
